UNIFORM POLICY

- 1. The school uniform must be worn with pride at all times. Students must be aware that they represent the school, hence they should ensure that their uniform is neat at all times and their behaviour is commendable.
- 2. All students attending BLUE HILLS COLLEGE are required to wear the prescribed uniform during school hours, and when on school trips (if required).
- 3. The school iersey/tracksuit top must be put away (if not worn) not tied around the waist.
- 4. School shoes must be black, with laces or buckles. No high heels, boots, platforms, flops or any other shoes (other than the prescribed school shoes) may be worn.
- 5. Boys' and girls' school shirts must always be neatly tucked in and the school tie must be worn at all times.
- 6. Girls' skirts must not be shorter than four (4) fingers above the knee, and should not be rolled up at the top.
- 7. Girls may wear grey trousers in WINTER. Skirts are compulsory during the rest of the year.
- 8. No jewellery other than a wrist watch is permitted (girls & boys); earrings are not allowed.
- 9. Hair must be kept neat. Girls with long hair must have it tied up; no outlandish hairstyles or colouring is allowed.
- 10. No nail varnish or make-up is allowed.
- 11. All boys must be cleanly shaven everyday, and their hair must be short and neat (acceptable hair styles).
- 12. On Sabbath, every learner must be in FORMAL church uniform (pink top and black skirts for girls and pink top and black pants for boys).
